Contemporary British playwright Alan Ayckbourn's play is directed by Wendy Watson for Durban Girls' College with Colin Chapman in the Associate Director's chair.

Uber-talented set designer Greg King has constructed a nifty realistic set which changes not once but twice during the show to accommodate three kitchen settings belonging to the three married couples who find themselves chaotically thrown together over three consecutive Christmas Eves!

A talented cast of six young people from Durban Girls' College and Durban High School give the play their all (in between attending lessons and sport fixtures) in their final year at school.

The venue for the production will be the Lecture Theatre, an intimate venue seating about 170 people who will provide the "4th wall" of the set. The play opens on the 16 March 2010 with a special price schools' preview and then will run nightly until the last show on the 20th March 2010. The schools' preview costs R50 while the other 4 shows cost R60. The show starts at 6:30pm and should be finished by about 9pm.
